



**Bus Trip to
Jay Peak, Vermont
March 25-29, 2009**



One of our most successful long weekend trips was to Jay Peak in March of 2001. During that season Jay Peak had a record snow fall of over 580 inches, more than anywhere in the West! Jay Peak always seems to get much more snow than other areas. What makes Jay a great trip is the very laid back atmosphere, uncrowded slopes, and the fact that it is the best value for a multi-day trip. We are lodging at the Hotel Jay, slopeside—ski in/ski out. Included is a wonderful buffet breakfast and an outstanding gourmet dinner each day.

The bus will depart on Wednesday afternoon, March 25th, from the Mountainside Pool parking area.

Total trip cost is \$750 per person, double occupancy. Non-members add \$30.

Special child cost is \$290, for children age 7 to 14. The child must stay in a room with two adults.

\$100 deposit is due by November 20, 2008, with the balance of payment due February 26, 2009.

Important Note

The success of any bus trip depends on the number of people attending. This price is based on 30 people. Fewer people may raise the cost; more people may lower the cost, as happened on the first Jay Peak trip. Let's try to make this trip another overwhelming success!
