



Watchung Amateur Ski Club New England Trip **Pico/Killington - March 18-21, 2010**

With more vertical drop than 80% of New England mountains, **Pico Mountain** offers mogul trails, glades, groomed cruisers and the new Triple Slope Terrain Park, all of which lead back to one classically-styled Vermont base lodge. First-timers can enjoy gentle learning trails and a new tow-rope, while more advanced skiers and snowboarders will enjoy finding their way into the glades on a fresh powder day. Pico's 50 trails, 214 skiable acres and seven lifts (including two high-speed quads) mean the slopes are never crowded and guests make the most out of their days. We'll also discuss the option of skiing at **Killington Resort** on Friday, six mountains featuring 141 diverse trails served by 22 lifts.
